## The Center for Youth and Family Solutions Actively Supports Vulnerable Families through the Illinois COVID-19 Response Fund

Peoria, Ill., July 10 – The Center for Youth and Family Solutions was one of the nonprofit organizations to receive funding through the Illinois COVID-19 Response Fund in its fourth and largest round of funding, which focuses on serving the state's most vulnerable populations due to the COIV-19 pandemic.

According to the agency's COVID Response Grants Coordinator, Jeff Turnbull, "in ten days, we have already provided over \$26,000 to support vulnerable families who truly are feeling the impact of COVID." While the agency has been able to provide support for basic needs, such as food vouchers, utility bills, rent/mortgage and transportation needs, they have also focused on supporting clients who have been financially impacted and unable to afford critical items that will help with their overall well-being.

"We have also helped our foster families who care for medically complex youth in care with critical therapeutic needs. For instance, we were able to purchase a mini in-door trampoline for tele-physical therapy and we also were able to provide payment for a physical therapy evaluation and on-going physical and developmental therapy. These children may not have received this support for a long time without this funding ," reported Turnbull.

The agency will continue to help support clients who are facing hard times during the pandemic with the goal of distributing all funds by August.
