## The Center for Youth and Family Solutions CEO Announcement: Trish Fox to Retire, and Patrick Phelan Appointed as Successor

Phelan is currently the CEO at Sinnissippi Centers, a community-based behavioral health center serving northern Illinois. "CYFS and the families we serve have been exceptionally fortunate to have enjoyed the dedicated and compassionate leadership of Trish Fox since our inception. And now we feel equally delighted to be able to transition the agency's care and keeping into the hands of Patrick Phelan--an experienced leader who shares our belief in the strength of the human spirit and our commitment to serving our families and communities with dignity, compassion, and respect," stated CYFS Board President, Julie Hohulin.

Patrick will be joining the agency on September 5<sup>th</sup>. "Throughout my career, I have greatly admired the work that Trish and the entire team at CYFS has done to serve children and families across central Illinois. It is clear that the staff and board of directors believe wholeheartedly in the mission, and in developing an organizational culture of compassion and collaboration. It is my honor to be asked to join such an incredible organization, and I will do everything in my power to support the team in continuing their life-changing work," stated Phelan.
